

2011 – clearly favourable development in climate change and energy


At risk of poverty or social exclusion had a clearly favourable development in both reports






Real GDP per capita increased between 2009 and 2011 and had a slight decrease in 2012





Total employment rate remains flat after the financial crisis






Part of the EU 2020 Strategy

Marked its highest level in 2011 but still away from the 3% target






Resource productivity in the EU increased between 2008 and 2010

In the same period DMC decreased






Part of the EU 2020 Strategy


Has been increasing since post-crisis 2009 when it marked its lowest level





Public debt has been steadily rising after the economic and financial crisis in 2008






Part of the EU 2020 Strategy

Slightly increased between 2009 and 2010






Part of the EU 2020 Strategy

Constantly moving in the favourable direction




Signs for reversal after a sharp fall due to the 2008 crisis?

ODA as percentage of GNI decreased in two consecutive years after peak in 2010


