
What is it all about?

- > Promoting <u>sustainable consumption</u> by
- > exploring novel ways of knowledge brokerage
- to improve the management of <u>potential political</u>, <u>social</u> and <u>economic contradictions</u> in the context of <u>economic growth</u>.



The challenge is **linking different communities**:

- (1) *linking science* and *policy* (follow different rules and rationalities);
- (2) improving the mutual understanding of the 'progrowth community' and the 'beyond-growth community'






System mapping as the primary tool of knowledge brokerage in RESPONDER will:

- (a) support *mutual understanding* ,
- (b) constitute the basis for systematizing empirical findings,
- (c) questioning *different model assumptions*,
- (d) analysing the *effects of*different policy options
 and
- (e) identifying *new* research questions.
